STRATEGIC OBJECTIVES

FIELDS OF ACTIVITY

CHILDREN IN THE FAMILY

Families, by definition, have a major potential for protecting children from all forms of violence. The family is the natural environment for the growth and welfare of all its members, but especially of the children.

We will help families to be a resilient environment for children.

CHILDREN IN THE ALTERNATIVE CARE

Friendly social services for children are “social services that respect, protect and ensure the rights of each child, including the right to participate and to be protected, in accordance with the best interests of the child.

We will contribute to increasing children’s resilience in alternative care services against the risk of abuse and to the development of friendly services.

CHILDREN IN THE JUDICIARY

A child-friendly justice is a system adjusted to the needs and rights of the child, including the right to an equitable trial, the right to information and participation, the right to privacy, integrity and dignity.

We will act to ensure a friendly justice for children victims and witnesses of violence.

CHILDREN IN THE FAMILY

Promotion of a family environment resilient to all forms of violence

- Developing parental skills of adults having children in their care
- Increasing resilience of children to violence and abuse
- Increasing the access of children and families to quality psycho-social assistance services

Decreasing the degree of tolerance of any form of violence

- Effective collaboration between NGOs and public authorities in implementing the national strategy for parental education
- Increased the access of adults having children in their care to programs and services for parental education
- Increased number of adults having developed their parental skills
- Increased access of children to programs of child abuse prevention, including prevention of child sexual abuse and exploitation
- Increased number of children resilient to abuse
- Permanent and accessible delivery of psychosocial assistance services for children victims of abuse and their families
- Increased number of children and adults accessing the psychosocial assistance services

CHILDREN IN THE ALTERNATIVE CARE

Capacity development of the alternative care services for the creation of a protective and favourable environment for the children victims

- Developing capacities of alternative care services to implement child protection policies
- Increasing the capacities of professionals in alternative care services to respond adequately to the needs of the children
- Increasing the resilience of children in alternative care to risk of abuse

Reduce the number of children suffering abuse of any type while in the alternative care system

- Increased number of alternative care services implementing child protection policies and providing an environment free of any form of violence
- Increased number of professionals trained to care for children who have suffered abuse and violence
- Increased number of children from the alternative care services able to identify and report violence

CHILDREN IN THE JUDICIARY

Promotion of a judiciary system friendly to the children victims/witnesses of crime

- Ensuring the integrated intervention in the case of children victims/witnesses of crime (developing the Barnahus-type services)
- Building the capacities of professionals in the justice system interacting with children victims / witnesses of abuse to respond adequately to the needs of the child

All children in contact with the justice system have access to integrate quality services

- Functional regional Barnahus centers ensure access of children and families to specialized services
- Increased number of professionals in the justice system skilled to interact with children at all stages of intervention
